## **Sports Day: Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

**As shared on the summer term dates, Sports Day will be on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June.**

Once again, the sports day races will be held on the field. Access to the field for any spectators will be down past the hall and EYFS and KS1 building on to the field.

To help our younger children, we will once again be splitting our EYFS (Nursery and Reception) and KS1 (Years 1 and 2) session so the children do not have to sit for as long.

All children are asked to come to school wearing their school PE kit and remain in their kit for the school day. Please can all parents ensure their child is wearing the **correct school PE kit**.

The children will be brought down to the field by members of staff and will sit together as a class. We respectfully ask all parents to remain on the far side of the race lanes and the children will sit on the near side closest to the school building. Children will need to have a water bottle and cap in school. If it is a sunny day, please make sure your child has sun cream applied before coming to school (they are welcome to bring sun cream with them to apply later on in the day).

As the children are coming down for and leaving their session, we respectfully ask our parents to stand back and not approach the children and allow them to sit as a class, particularly our Nursery and Reception. Once they have finished, we will be asking all parents to give them a wave from their side and then parents who are not staying can leave once the children have moved. Please respect our request and help us to make it easier for the children and do not approach as they are leaving as this can upset some of our younger pupils.

We want to keep our sports day fun and full of smiles!  
All we need now is for this wonderful weather to continue.
