Dear Parents/Carers,

Instrumental Lessons

We would like to remind you that we are continuing to offer a wide range of instrument lessons at school.

Keyboard	Keyboard (limited number of places)
Woodwind Instruments	Oboe, clarinet, flute and bassoon
String Instruments	Violin
Percussion	Drum kit (limited number of spaces)

- Lessons will take place weekly during the school day.
- There is an annual charge of £120 for instrumental lessons, which equates to less than £3.50 per 20 minute weekly group lesson, as school subsidises the cost.
- Payment can be made in full by 2nd September or by standing order of £12 per month for 10 months, from October to July, payable on the 1st of the month.
- There will be a minimum of 35 lessons per year. Where a teacher misses a lesson, they will make every effort to catch up. If a child misses a lesson, this will be caught up if possible, but there is not an obligation on the teacher to do so.
- Children will need an instrument to learn and practise on, which can be loaned either from the Music Service or from the school. Any books required will be advised by the instrumental teacher.
- Children in receipt of free school meals will receive free tuition, but need to pay for the books and any medal or exam fees.
- Attendance at all lessons and completion of practice at home is essential for a good rate of progress.

If you are experiencing difficulty in meeting the charges, or would like advice about purchasing an instrument (new or second hand) please contact myself, Mrs Amison, via the school office.
