WELCOME BACK

Welcome back! Below is a brief outline of what we will be learning in each subject during the second part of our Spring Term.

Values and Virtues

This half term our values and virtues theme is being Eloquent and Truthful.

Children will learn about being <u>Faith-filled</u> towards understanding the Word of God and how we can make a difference to those around us through our thinking and actions. They will understand how good it is to be <u>Hopeful</u> n their daily lives and the importance of participation in class discussions in RE. We will also be looking at the importance of determination when following through on heir thoughts, prayers and pledges towards being a better Christian.

Religious Education

In RE this term, children will be learning about special celebrations that we take part in at church. We will also be learning about the liturgical time of Lent and Holy Week in preparation towards Easter. The children will have the opportunity to lead times of Collective Worship and Class based liturgy.

<u>English</u>

Our focus text for this half term is 'Traction Man'. Throughout the topic, we will look at character description. Our class targets in literacy are:

Writing - To use the expanded noun phrase with imaginative and appropriate vocabulary Reading - To make predictions for our class text and also show empathy with the main character

<u>Maths</u>

In maths, we will be learning about Shape and Space. We will be learning about the properties of different 2-d shapes and 3-d shapes. We will learning about properties of different regular and irregular polygons. We will also be working with symmetry, identifying and drawing lines of symmetry in shapes. Towards the ed of the half term we will be studying measurement in temperature, capacity and volume.

<u>Science</u>

This half-term, we will be learning about Plants. We will be exploring healthy lifestyles, exercise and what our bodies need to grow as we get older.

P.E

This half-term, Year 2 will continue to also have PE on Monday and Wednesday afternoons with Mr Smith.

Art

During this half term Year Two will be exploring local area art work in Stoke-on-Trent and learning about pottery designers such as Clarice Cliff.

History

This half term, we will be developing our understanding of our local area and learning about how Kidsgrove has developed over the last 100 years since the Victorian times.

PSHE
