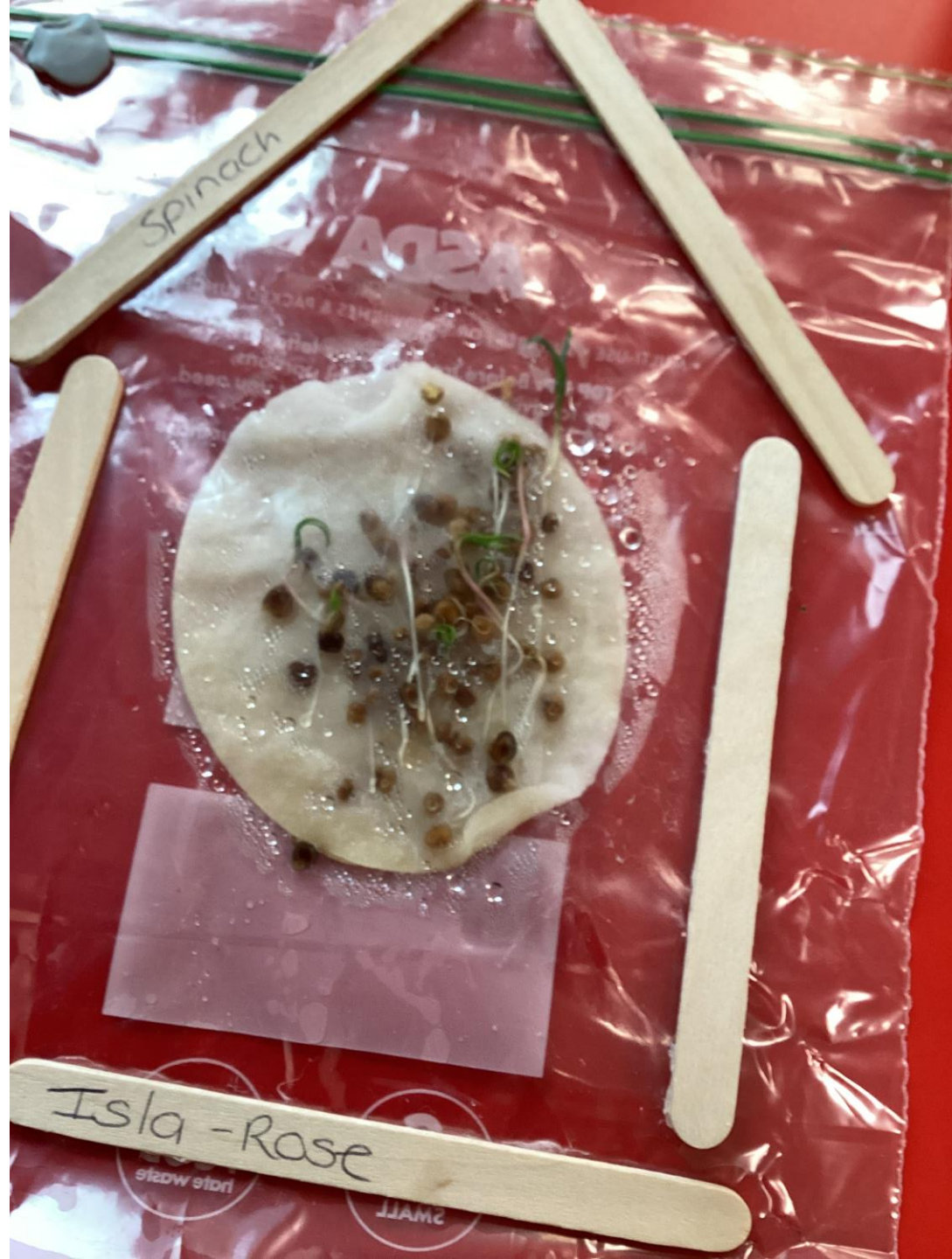

Our Early Years children have planted strawberries inside their old wellies!





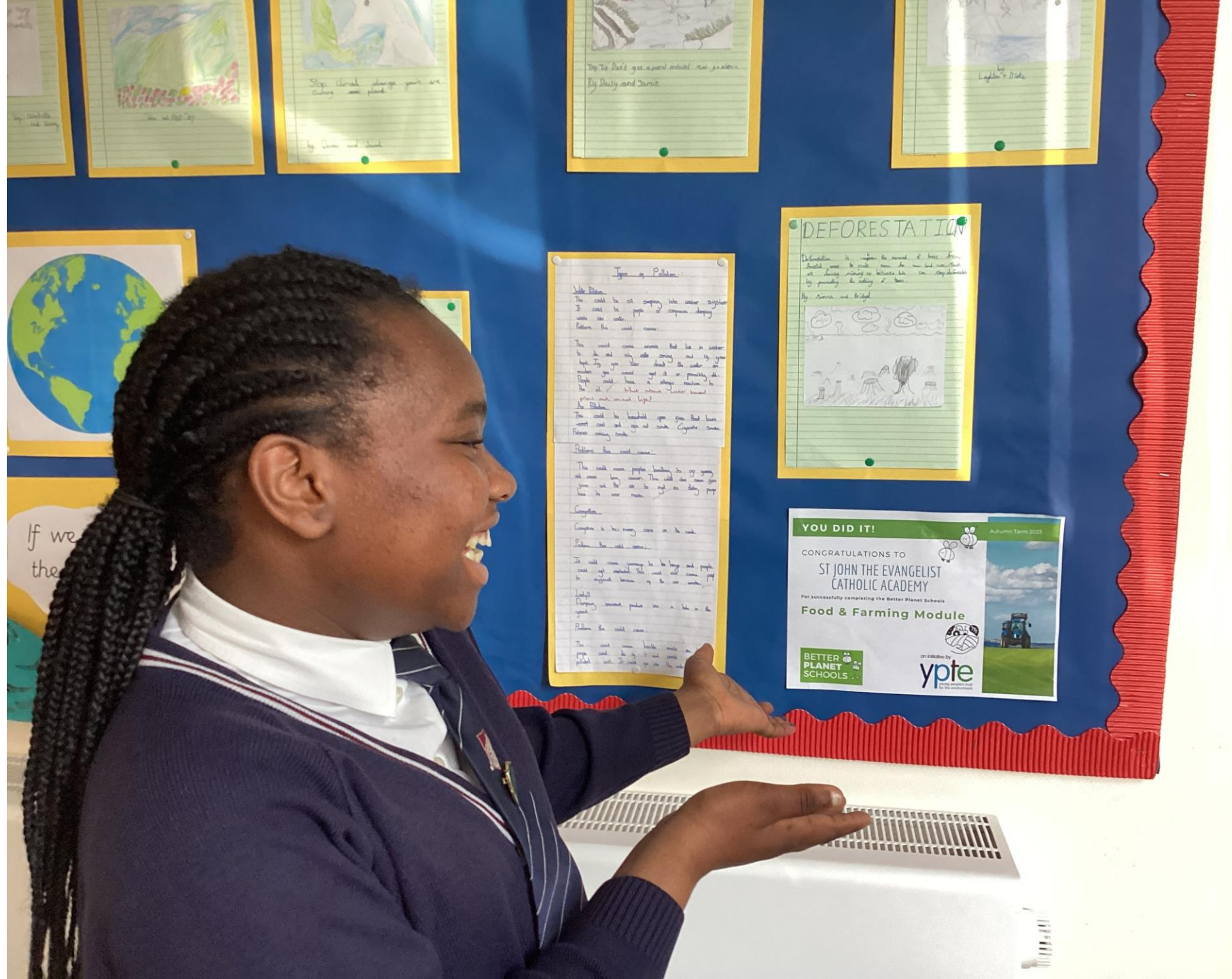
